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TCAFAS Royalty Rules of Conduct

The TCAFAS Royalty are Representatives of Teller County Association of Fairs And Shows (TCAFAS) and will promote the association using their western heritage. As a TCAFAS representative one will act, speak, and dress the part of being royalty.

The winners will receive a crown and sash that is theirs to keep after their reign, a crown that will be passed on from year to year, and a buckle upon the completion of their duties.

The term serves as TCAFAS Royalty will start the Saturday night you are crowned, until the following years royalty is crowned.

Royalty **Must** either live in Teller County, be registered in Teller County 4H, Enrolled in a Teller County school district, and not have held the title before.

Royalty cannot be pregnant at tryouts, or become pregnant during their reign, or have children.

Age requirements for Royalty are as follows: Queen/Lady in waiting ages 15-20 years of age at the time of tryouts, Princess ages 10-14 years of age as of January 1 of current year.

As a representative of the Association it is your responsibility to maintain a positive image!

❖ Royalty Responsibilities:

- Must be on your best behavior in every appearance. **Present a positive attitude** and be willing to help in any way that best promotes the TCAFAS organization.
- Attend all (to most) events set by the royalty coordinators. Events may include parades, rodeos, and the Teller County fair (see list). If you are unable to attend an event you must contact your coordinators no less than two (2) days prior to the event to get approval of your absences. (Sudden illness accepted)
- If Royalty is a student they must meet their school's eligibility requirements to participate. Proof of eligibility is required from the school at each monthly meeting.
- The royalty will need to stay at an event until the coordinator or a designated TCAFAS representative has dismissed you.
- **TCAFAS Crown and Sash will not be used at an event that is not preapproved by the TCAFAS board and/or the Royalty Coordinators. They may also not be used in photos for your social media (Facebook, snapchat, twitter, etc.) unless you have prior approval from the coordinators and /or the TCAFAS board**

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- ❖ Conduct:
 - Professional image and language will be used at all times. Royalty should conduct them self's as if they are in the Crown at all time to include social media pictures and posts.
 - While representing TCAFAS in crown or out there will be no slander of the organization, you will submit any grievances in writing to the coordinators who will present them to the board at the next TCAFAS general meeting.
 - Language will be professional at all times, This means speaking with respect and **NO CUSSING**
 - **NO CHEWING GUM!** (While in crown)
 - **NO TEXTING** or TALKING on cell phones during an event (unless it is to the TCAFAS coordinator). There will be no hesitation if asked to surrender you phone.
 - **NO DRINKING, DRUGS, SMOKING, OR CHEWING TOBACCO IN OR OUT OF CROWN.**
- ❖ BOYFRIENDS, Spouse, and family:
 - **NO** outward displays of affection.
 - **Will NOT** be a constant companion.
 - We will use a 3-strike you're out policy. Although Royalty can be released from their duties/responsibilities at the coordinators discretion with the majority approval from the TCAFAS board.
- ❖ Appearance:
 - When representing the TCAFAS organization you must wear your Crown, sash, cowboy hat, and colored or **dark** blue jeans (without holes or bling on pockets) with a long sleeve button up shirt.
 - If you have facial pricings it must be removed during all event representing TCAFAS
 - Hair and outfits will be coordinated on an event by event basis.
 - Boots should be clean and presentable (i.e. polished).
 - Long sleeved shirts must be tucked in or cinched in with a belt overtop.
- ❖ Horse:
 - **Ownership of a horse is not required**
 - **Horses will only be ridden if and only if all Royalty are able to, and only under the discretion of the Coordinators or TCAFAS board.** Queen and Lady in Waiting will be required to ride in grand entries at the Coordinators discretion.
 - Must provide your own transportation.
 - Must ride a safe and controlled horse at all times.
 - Tack and horse will be clean at all times.

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TCAFAS Royalties Parents/Guardians

As the parent/guardian of the TCAFAS Royalty you will be asked to provide transportation to events. Also there will be a financial need to support the royalty during their term. This includes gas money, clothing, and accommodations. It is understood that during the reign of your royalty you will not interact with them at events it is the job of the Coordinators to supervise them.

The TCAFAS Crown and Sash will only be worn for TCAFAS approved events.

While your royalty is representing TCAFAS ether in crow or out you will not slander the organization. All grievances will be presented in writing to the coordinator who will present it to the TCAFAS Board at the next general meeting.

During the reign of your royalty from time to time there will be photographs taken at events they will attend. These photographs may be used for purposes such as promotional (i.e. flyers and brochures), publications (i.e. fair books), and the TCAFAS websites and Facebook pages. Images that might cause embarrassment, or portray the participants in a negative light will not be used. The TCAFAS board and royalty coordinators along with you as parent/guardian will examine all pictures being posted to enable us to decide what not to display.

Along with photographs there will be information about the royalty along with their first and last names posted on the website, Facebook pages, and business cards. These may also include contact information (i.e. email address, mailing address, and phone numbers). Everything that will be posted on the website, Facebook pages, or business cards will be shown to parent/guardian before being posted.

As TCAFAS Royalties parent/guardian:

As a parent/guardian I understand that the roll of Royalty is a servant/leader position. They will serve the TCAFAS board and community during their rein and will display leadership qualities at all times. All Royalty are treated equally, they will work as a team to make this a successful rein.

I understand I will have to provide transportation and some financial support.

I understand that the Coordinators are their Supervisors.

I understand that the TCAFAS Crown and Sash will not be used at an event that is not preapproved by the TCAFAS board and/or the Royalty Coordinators

I allow the TCAFAS board and Royalty coordinators to post positive images of my child with their first and last name, on the website, Facebook pages, or other promotional publications.
