OPEN CLASS QUILTS

In Open Class there will be a \$2.00 fee for each Quilt(s) entered

Entry Fees are Non-Refundable

All quilts entered in the 2023 Fair must be completed between August 2018 and August 1, 2023, (5 years) in order to compete.

Quilts that have been previously entered in Teller County Association of Fairs and Shows may **NOT** be entered again.

Notice to all Quilters – Quilt Judging will be Tuesday, August 1 after 11:00am

Quilt Judging will **not** be competing with any other indoor projects, so judging will be more successful and enjoyable event with more opportunity for the community to watch and listen to the judges and ultimately create more interest for the craft of quilting. We ask that all attending ***PLEASE*** be quiet and be respectful of the judge's time and the information they provide.

PLEASE Silence (**ALL**) Electronic Devices during the judging. Questions may be asked and the end of Judging.

All Judged Quilts are ***final***.

Entry form will be on the TCAFAS web-site and also on **Quilters Above the Clouds** web-site.

Please have your Registration, Fees and your Quilt(s) to the Fair Grounds by **10:15am** Tuesday August 1, 2023.

Doors open at 8:30am to except Quilt Entries **ONLY**

NO Quilt(s) will be Accepted after 10:30am on August 1, 2023

Judging will start at **11:00am**. With a lunch break at 1:00pm. Resume Judging at 1:30pm.

Judging should be completed by 4:00pm

Quilts will be released at 5:00pm on *Sunday* August 6th 2023... **NO EARLY RELEASES**

Quilts MUST be picked up no later than 7:00pm On Sunday August 6th 2023

Quilts will be released from the same building they are received in. Please bring your claim ticket to prove entry, ownership when picking up quilts. Claim tickets are required for Release of quilts.

Please Read Open Class Quilts RULES & DEFINITONS

Colorado Quilt Council will provide a special ribbon to one quilt, chosen by the appropriate Colorado Quilt Council Judge on the day of judging, the maker having entered the Teller County Association of Fairs and Shows for the first time.

Other Ribbons may be awarded.

First time Ribbons will be awarded to youth under 18 years of age.

Best Of Show Quilt in the Youth Division, will Receive a Member Certificate (Valued at \$10.00) to Quilters Above the Clouds quilt guild, 2024 year

For Best of Show in Open Class, Quilter Above the Clouds will provide membership certificates (Valued at \$20.00 each)

to the Quilters Above the Clouds quilt guild, 2024 year

Quilters Above the Clouds members are eligible to win.
